Goal:

Evangelism Mentoring Teams (EMT) is an opportunity for volunteers to share Christ with the lost by serving a home mission.

Activities:

Team members will need to be flexible and adapt to the ministry once on site. The team will follow a plan produced with the pastor. Outreach in the neighborhoods and follow up on prospects is a regularly planned activity. Team members will also provide organizational leadership and training.

Skills Needed:

Team members will possess a love for the Lord and a desire to share him with others. The ability to comfortably speak with strangers is important, as well as organizational skills in collecting and recording prospect lists for follow-up visits. The inclusion of congregational members on a canvass or follow-up visit is an important part of the program.

Commitment Needed:

EMT work includes periodic visits throughout the year (two to four weeks at a time).

EMT Training:

WELS Kingdom Workers will hold periodic training sessions to help, encourage, and hone ministry skills. Previous experience is valuable. Willingness to serve is a must; expertise will come with training and doing.
